The system solutions are available from stock and as single items. To document the effectiveness of the boxes, all the solutions are pre-qualified in a winter and a summer scenario on the basis of the European norm AFNOR NF S99-700. The certification is issued for empty packaging without transported goods, the 'worst case scenario'.

All the system solutions consist of the following components:

- Polystyrene box
- Cooling agent (foam bricks)
- Outer / shipping carton
- Inner carton (payload)
- Packaging instructions
- Certification report

Individual solutions are produced in consultation with our customers. Our development team creates a draft design in the form of a CAD drawing. A prototype is then made which is used for further testing.


Climate Chamber Test

The average temperatures are 27°C for the summer scenario and 7°C for the winter scenario.
